Involves creation and documentation of technical design, creating ViryaNet software application configuration design, and design, development, and unit testing of project customizations in Java technologies, as required.
- Develop interfaces and implement business rules logic, coded using ViryaNet product APIs.
- Enhance or analyze the current data model used in the Oracle database, and create database stored procedures and functions, as designed.
- Conduct unit testing as standard development methodology, and participate directly in quality assurance testing for project implementations.
- Perform product installations, as assigned, and build software delivery, with release notes, as required.
- Provide site acceptance testing support of a technical nature, during the Customer Acceptant Testing phase of the project implementation, as needed.
- Participate in system integration testing and other technical deployment activities off-site or on-site at the customer location, as required.

- Actively participate in internal and customer project status meetings, with ownership and follow up on identified tasks.
- Adhere to department standards and policies for task management and project management - accurately report work time and expenses in corporate PSA tool, and pro-actively provide status and progress updates to the Project Manager and other relevant team members, as needed.
